CAPELLA CRACOVIENSIS is a cultural institution of the City of Krakow and a modern orchestra and choir which aims for historically informed performance of early music. For the city – the most important historic cultural centre in the country – Capella Cracoviensis is one of its identifying features that brings back to life the works of the Golden Age of Polish culture and the most precious pieces of historic international repertoire, from Renaissance polyphony to pre-Romantic operas. The ensemble has made its mark by introducing to Polish concert life the most significant works of music literature (such as Handel’s oratorios and operas) and presenting outstanding pieces of the Polish baroque in their characteristic context. Capella Cracoviensis has also explored chamber music repertoire and carried out stage opera performances.

The ensemble has developed dynamically, gathering top Polish musicians specialising in early music and eminent international guests. In the 2010/2011 season, Capella Cracoviensis hosted such concertmasters as Alessandro Moccia, Alberto Stevanin, Martyna Pastuszka, Fabio Ravasi, Peter Hanson, ensembles – NACHTMUSIQUE, FRETWORK, OLTREMONTANO, LES SACQUEBOUTIERS DE TOULOUSE, MUSICA FIATA – and conductors – Alfredo Bernardini, Andrew Parrott, Fabio Bonizzoni, Andreas Sperring, Ralf Sochaczewsky, and Paul Goodwin.
